



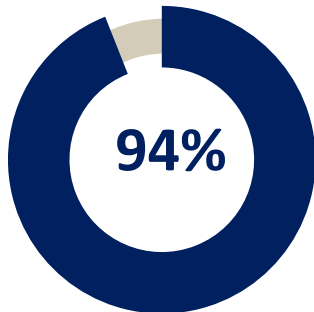

RE: STATEWIDE SURVEY—ARIZONA



Virtually every voter in the state of Arizona is paying attention to the nomination of Brett Kavanaugh to the Supreme Court, and a majority support his confirmation.

A Lot/Some**

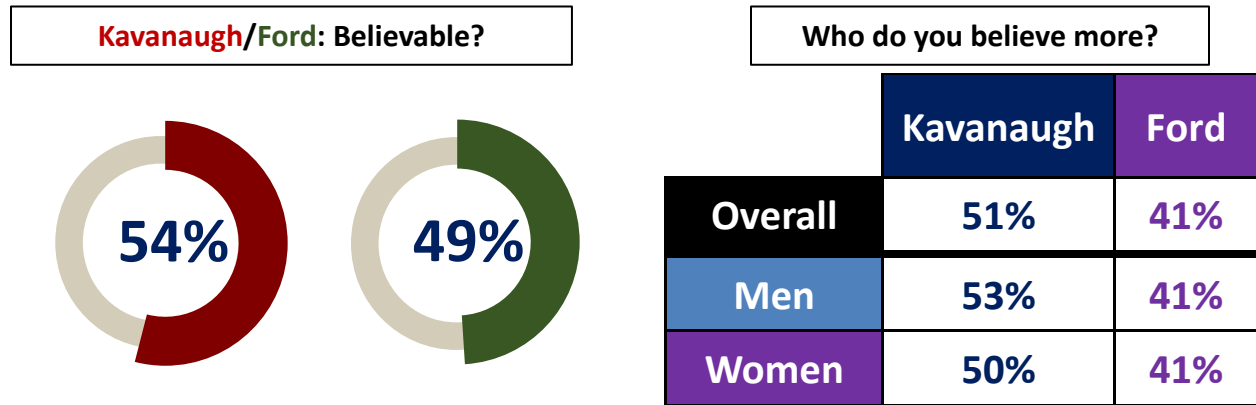


Support/Oppose Kavanaugh on S.C.

	Total Support	Total Oppose
Overall	51%	40%
Men	53%	37%
Women	49%	43%

Importantly, by a margin of 49%-43%, women in Arizona support confirmation.

A majority also give an edge to Kavanaugh in believability.



Asked whether they found Brett Kavanaugh and Christine Blasey Ford believable in their testimony, more Arizona voters found Kavanaugh believable.

By a nine-point margin, women found Kavanaugh to be the more credible.

METHODOLOGY

Public Opinion Strategies conducted a statewide survey of 665 voters in Arizona using an IVR+ methodology, which includes strict quota management and hand-dialed cell phones in addition to IVR dialing (interactive voice response). The margin of error is +3.8%. Interviews were collected September 27th following the testimonies of Christine Blasey Ford and Brett Kavanaugh.
